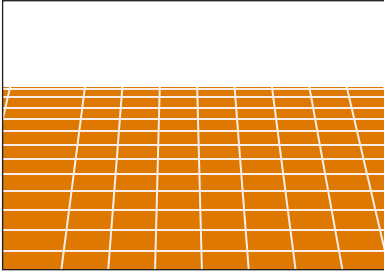
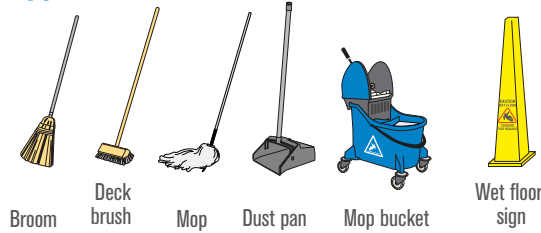


# FLOOR CLEANING PROCEDURES



## Supplies needed:

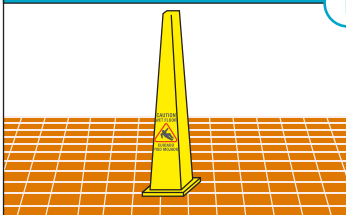


**NOTE:** Use dedicated mop and deck brush for front of house, and separate set for back of house

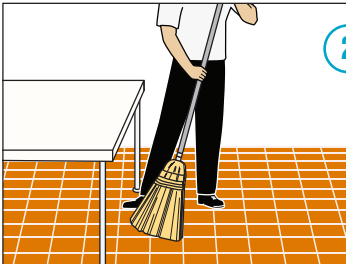


All Surface Floor Cleaner

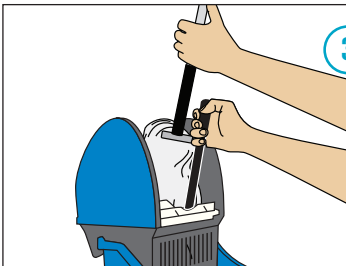
### PROCEDURE - As needed during operating hours



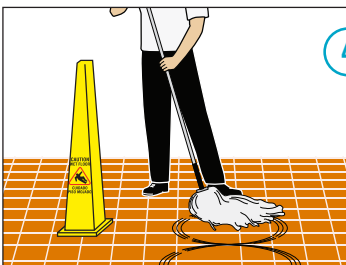
- 1 • Place wet floor sign in area being mopped.



- 2 • Pick up trash; sweep floor. Place debris in trash can.

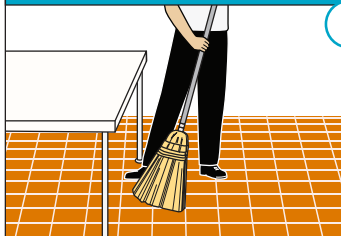


- 3 • Fill clean mop bucket 1/2 full (4 gal) with hot water and pour in the packet of All Surface Floor Cleaner solution.  
• Dip clean mop into All Surface Floor Cleaner solution and wring mop into bucket.

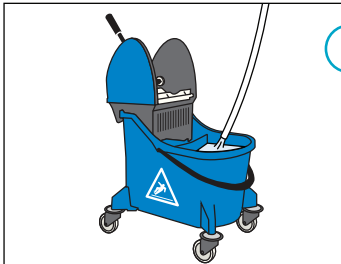


- 4 • Use mop to clean the floor using a figure-8 motion. Repeat process until entire floor is mopped.  
• Rinse with water, as needed, or wipe up excess solution with mop or squeegee to drain.  
• Rinse mop and mop bucket thoroughly after each use.  
• Hang mops to air dry.  
**NOTE:** Prepare fresh cleaning solution when mop water becomes visibly dirty.

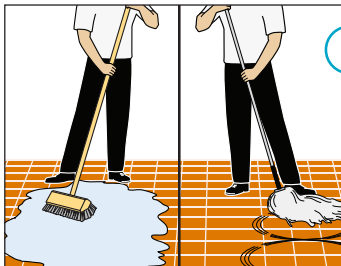
### PROCEDURE - At Close



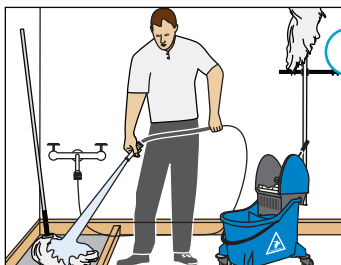
- 1 • Pick up trash; sweep floor. Place debris in trash can.



- 2 • Prepare All Surface Floor Cleaner using a clean mop bucket.  
• Use mop to clean the floor using a figure-8 motion. Repeat process until entire floor is mopped.



- 3 • Deck brush kitchen nightly.  
• Deck brush lobby weekly.  
• Deck brush high traffic areas in lobby nightly.  
• Rinse or damp mop cleaned area to pick up remaining solution.  
**NOTE:** Prepare fresh cleaning solution when mop water becomes visibly dirty.



- 4 • Rinse mop, deck brush and mop bucket thoroughly.  
• Hang mops to air dry.  
**NOTE:** Detail clean mop bucket weekly. Change mop heads when they become visibly dirty.
